Yesterday you started making hearts and bringing them to me as gifts. I briefly commented that they were different sizes. You noticed this too! Quickly, you ordered them, smallest to largest. Then you used correct mathematical language to describe the order they were in: "Look at the smallest heart here, Mrs King. The this is the next smallest, and the middle one, until the biggest heart here", you told me. You proudly glued them in order from smallest to largest. While you were gluing, you explained again which was the smallest, middle, and largest hearts.

After this, you added some writing: "I love you Mrs King, by Georgia". I was so excited to see you choosing to write spontaneously like this. Today I watched you do MORE measuring... wow! Together with your friends, you made lengths of wool, then described their length. You are practicing the same maths learning in a different context. We are noticing maths in so much of your play.
